GFP is committed to being ethical and credible in our relationships with Indigenous communities, the public, stakeholders, and members of the communities where we undertake business.

GFP is committed to open and transparent communications and providing informative, timely, and accurate information which will be disclosed in accordance with applicable legal and regulatory requirements.

GFP's Public Disclosure Protocol ensures information is provided to the public and stakeholders and in various forums and vehicles based on audience interests, perception of risk, and preferred means of communication.

Our goal is to ensure a clear understanding of our activities to allow audiences to make informed decisions through readily accessible information and open dialogue, and with opportunities to share views and perspectives and have questions addressed.

Under this Protocol, GFP commits to, but is not limited to:

- Communicate broadly to the public via various forums (newsletters, fact sheets, emails, website, social media) and provide stakeholder briefings to ensure open and transparent communication;
- Manage communications effectively, maintaining two-way communication channels with the public and stakeholders to provide information and address feedback or concerns;
- Receive, document and respond to feedback or concerns, including those related to impacts on the environment, from Indigenous communities, stakeholders and the public;
- Communicate significant project developments such milestone achievements, scheduling advancements or delays;
- Communicate promptly about unplanned activities or events of significance, or impacts on the environment either planned or unplanned, that may result in offsite impact or public or media interest;
 - For example, significant operational developments such as labour disputes; expansion or changes in facility design or operation; fires; impact of natural events; industrial accidents; spills or releases of materials to the environment exceeding regulatory limits; environmental performance and monitoring reports as may be required by Regulations

- Post event reports on GFP's public website www.globalfirstpower.com;
- Report and post emissions and spills in accordance with reporting requirements through established notification protocols with regulatory and municipal and provincial agencies;
- Consult periodically with the public and stakeholders to confirm types of information of public interest and desired methods and frequency of receiving information;
- Inform the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission of disclosures made under the public disclosure protocol at the time of, or before, such disclosure
- Publicly post the Public Disclosure Protocol on GFP's public website www.globalfirstpower.com;
